You are welcome to go home for the night, if you live locally, or book accommodations at another area hotel at your own expense. If you do not stay on site, and if the Boot Camp is a 2-day event, you should plan to return early the 2nd day by 9:00 am. Returning on time on the 2nd day (if applicable) is mandatory for the success of the program.
